Court Stay Granted in Federal DIR Litigation

The National Community Pharmacists Association (NCPA) has announced in a recent release that the U.S. District Court of the District of Columbia has granted a stay in *NCPA v. Becerra*, which is a case that is challenging whether DIR fees imposed on pharmacies are legal. The plaintiffs have requested a stay (delay) in the case because CMS has recently released a proposed rule on DIR. The plaintiffs are assessing whether the proposed rule addresses concerns from pharmacy.
